. Situation of People with Intellectual Disabilities

1. Situation of I.D. in general, services for I.D. Provided such as,

1) Finding & diagnosis of I.D.

- (1) Sometimes the medical doctor or psychologies will not inform the parents directly that their child is I.D., just to avoid the shock of the parents.
- (2) Some of the parents think their child can go to normal school and send them as soon as possible to school or keep it away from the society.
- (3) Usually the parents know their child is I.D. at the age of 17 years.
- (4) During the population census by the government they come to know that there is a lot of I.D. but they did not take it seriously.

2) Early intervention

- We do not have special program for this one.
- They go to early intervention if a parent doubt a child and discuss with us.

3) Education

- Indonesia has special schools for intellectual disabilities as kindergartens, elementary schools, junior high school and senior high schools, those are from government as well as non-government.

4) Vocational Training

- Vocational training is a special school program or subject of special school, such as: house keeping, kitchen work, working with textiles, agriculture, paperwork, woodwork.

The vocational training is mostly for adult I.D. because they have never had it in class before.

5) Employment

The constitutions of the Department of Labour are a.o.:

- One disabled person must be working among 100 employees otherwise the company has to pay Rp. 200,000,000- (200 million rupiahs)
- So we have to prepare them before a.o. :
 - cleaning services
 - house keeper
 - car park service

6) Financial Assistance

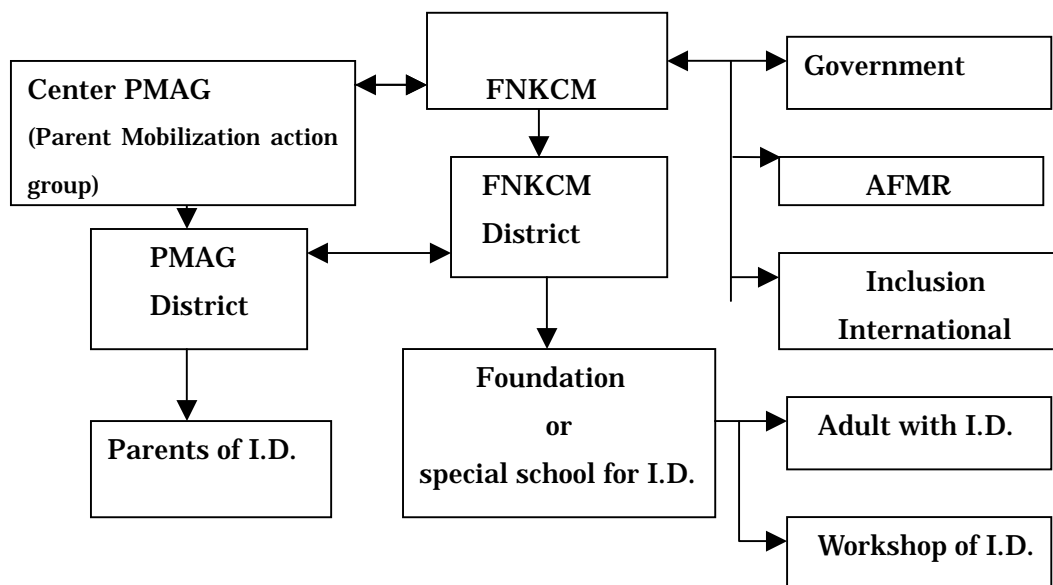
- Government

7) Others

- Allow the I.D. to joint the election day in 2004.
- The FNKCM is the only national organization in Indonesia and 2003 has 320 member institutions in whole Indonesia.
 - a) Looking funds for their member local as well as international sponsors.

- b) To hold training every year for teachers, parents, I.D. children a.o. by interlaid.
 - c) To establish Parents Association at every institution /special schools (SLB).
 - d) To promote “Adult Training” at all member institution/SLB.

 - FNKCM is a full member of AFMR(Asian Federation on Mental Retardation)
 - In 2005 AFMR Congress (ACMR=Asian Congress on Mental Retardation) will be held in Indonesia (Yogjakarta).

Laws are made for I.D. but not sufficient yet.

4. **Community – Based Rehabilitation Programs (system, organization responsible)**
 - Made Parents Organization Center and District(as POTI or PMAG)
 - Adult Training for I.D. and parents about services and vocational training.
 - Until now, parents organization has been established but we have to support them due to most of parents come from poor family.
 - The parents leave their children to the teachers. They only have to pay their school fee.
