Back Ground and Present Situation

Needs:

Children with Mental illness (0-6 ages)

Number: 110,000

Prevalence rate: 0.110%

About 15,000 children added every year.

Most of them are autistic children.

(data on the second china national sample survey on disability(2006-2007))



- What we have done?
- Selected 31 experimental cities, 32 centers are established.
- Confirmed the rehabilitation centers in province level.
- Constituted the national guidance of experts group.
- Wrote teaching materials.
- Launched training course for the technical staff.
- (According to the Outline for the Development of disabled persons' enterprise which was ratified by state council.)



Problems

- Lack of early intervention which impacted the rehabilitation effect.
- Lack of rehabilitation training institutions, less children with autism with/without mental illness can benefited.
- Lack of scientific and effective assessment tools.
- The technical staff lack of systematic training of rehabilitation.



Resource Available

Central government support

- Gradually solve the problem of the education of children with autism. (The policy can help us to get budget from local Go.)
- Give assistance to the poor children with disabilities.

(According to the opinion on promoting the disabled persons' enterprise declared by CPC Central Committee and state council, March 28, 2008)



CDPF (China Disabled Persons' Federation) is powerful.

- It has a nationwide umbrella network reaching every part of China with about 80,000 full-time workers.
- Experts group.
- They are professional and participator on the rehabilitation of autistic children from different universities.




OBJECTIVE

- Choose evaluation tools and implement test.
- Analysis data.
- Writing the final report.

ACTIVITIES

- Training course.
- National training course.
- Time : five days
- Content : evaluation model and practice.
- Trainees: 3 staff/teacher every province (about 100 people)
- Budget : central government.
- Provincial training course.
- Budget : local government.
- Each province decides the size and timing.

- Get the support of the special schools and rehabilitation institutions.
