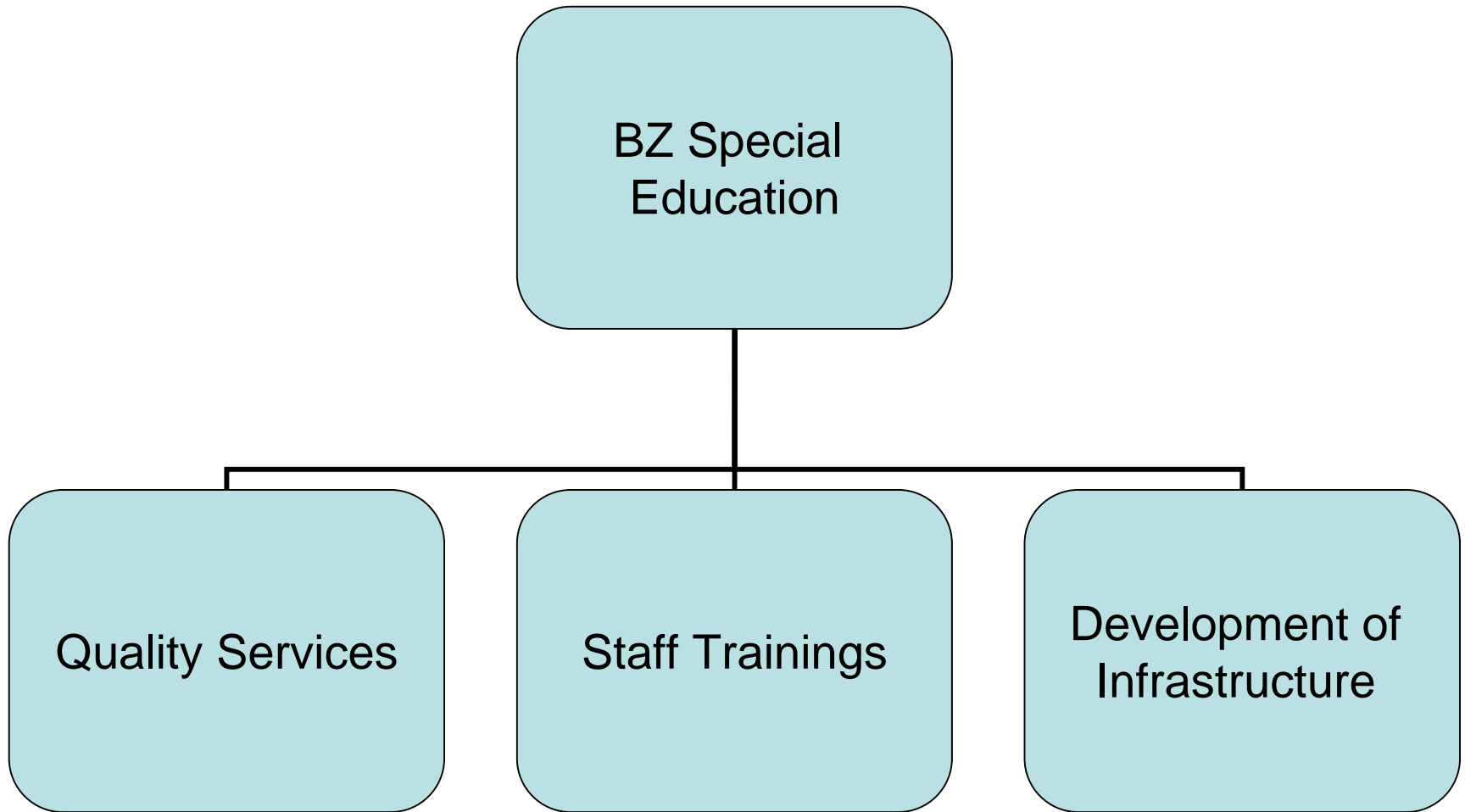

We trained 10 PWIDs for employment skills especially blue pottery, cutting and sewing. For this TEVTA was asked for curriculum sharing

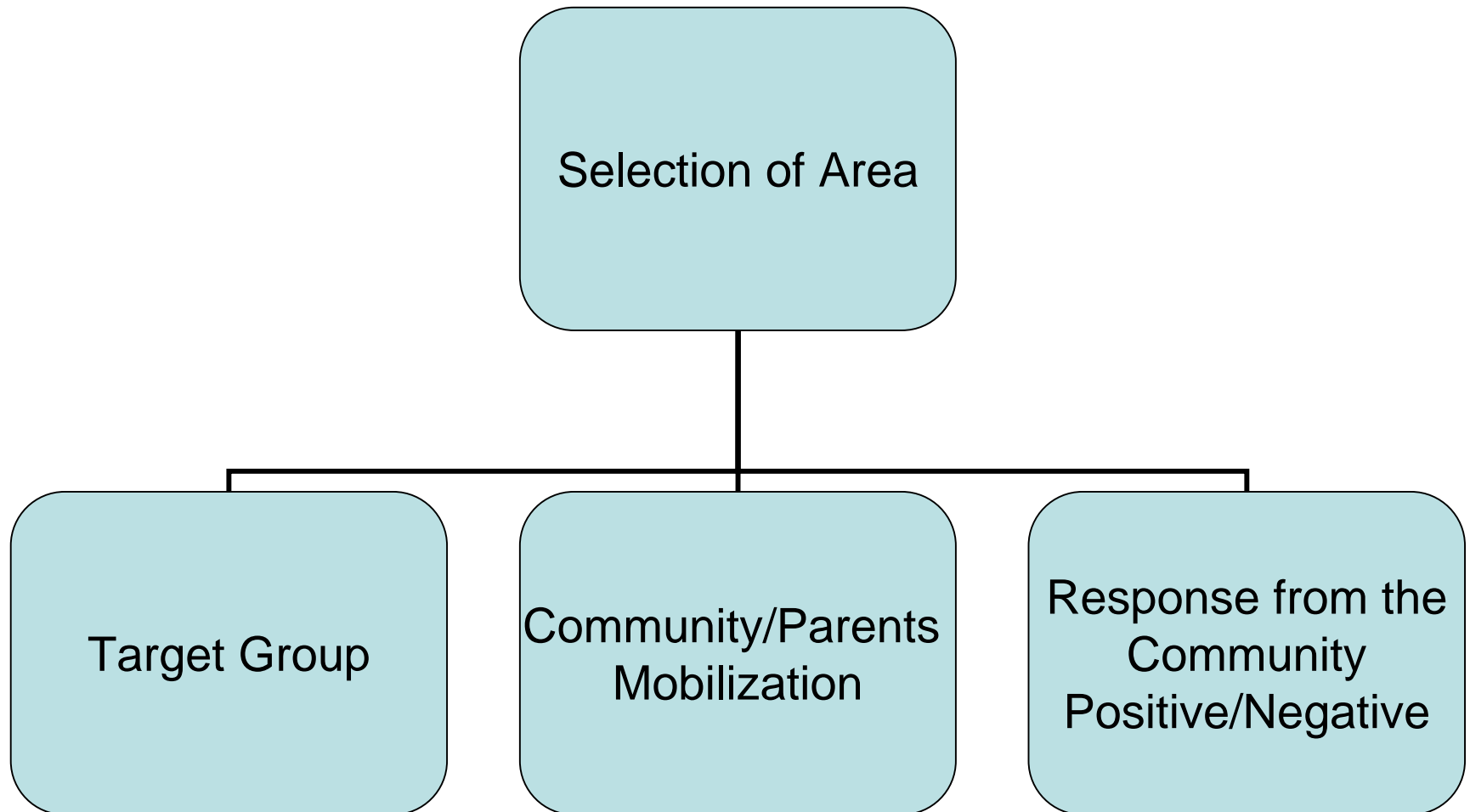
Input in the Implementations

Problems Faced

- Lack of support form the community towards the institutions.
- Non availability of information and no culture of internal cooperation form the community as well as different institutions.
- Limited resources such as material and human resources to work with this segment of the society

Problems Faced

During the implementation of this curriculum we faced some problems like:

- **To attain the concentration on work**
- **Different and non cooperative attitude of the family members**
- **Non cooperative attitude of the traders**
- **Less wage of the labor for IDs**
- **Try to change the external environment for the person with disability but the participation from the community is low.**
- **At initial stages the IDs work quality is not sufficient**

The target group of these action plans was the PWIDS of B.Z.U centre aged 8 and above.

Stages of the Action Plan

Measures Taken

Infrastructure is already there but I have taken some measures to reorganize the infrastructure to fulfill the Action Plan. Vocational teacher is nominated to trained IDs for above skills.

At this stage selected the 10 IDs to trained them new techniques.

All the steps are taken for the betterment of IDs and supportive to the family. During all the stages it was compulsory to assess them their ability and the interest regarding above skills. Some assessment tools are utilized to evaluate their abilities

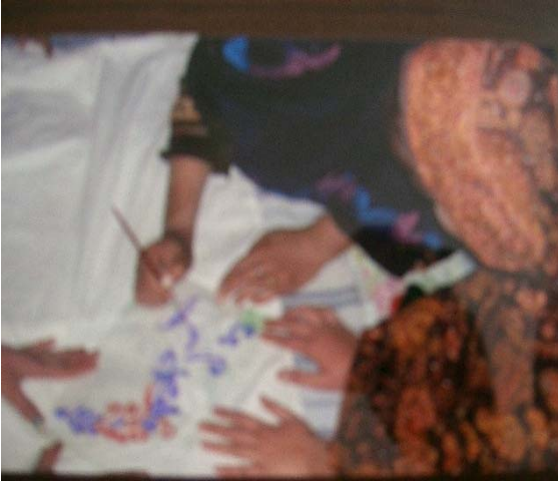
Stages of the Action Plan
